Feb. 17 - Depart USA to Tel Aviv

Today we depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

Feb. 18 - Arrive Tel Aviv, Overnight Tiberias

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel in Tiberias for check-in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

Feb. 19 - Sea of Galilee, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Tabgha, Boat Ride, Jordan River

Today we travel around the Sea of Galilee. Enter the 2,000 year-old remains of Capernaum (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Stop at Tabgha, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the Church of the Fish and Loaves (Luke 9). With your Bible in hand, cross the waters of the Sea of Galilee aboard a Kinnereth Sailing Company boat. Remember your baptism at the Yardenit Baptismal site, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3). Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Feb. 20 – Day of Service to Local Ministry

Feb. 21 – Northern Territory, Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Golan Heights

Today spend time exploring the Northern Territory of Israel. Visit Tel Dan, one of ancient Israel's boundary markers - "From Dan to Beersheba." Journey to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). Travel through the Golan Heights and better understand their strategic importance to the security of Israel. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Feb. 22 - Bet Shean, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Nazareth, Cana, Caesarea, Jerusalem

Today it's on to the magnificent ruins of Bet Shean where you will tour the impressive excavations of Scythopolis, one of the ten cities of the Decapolis. Continue on your journey to Mt. Carmel. Biblically, Mt. Carmel is referenced most often as a symbol of beauty and fertility. To be given the "splendor of Carmel" was to be blessed indeed (Isaiah 35:2). Travel the ancient caravan route to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2:23). Recall Jesus' first miracle as you pass through Cana (John 2). Wonder at the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new covenant (Acts 10), and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23). Stop and view the Holy City of Jerusalem before transferring to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Feb. 23 - Valley of the Shadow, Masada, Dead Sea

Today you will pass through the Judean Wilderness paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the Valley of the Shadow. Enjoy a visit to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod and famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. On the way back to Jerusalem, stop

at the Shores of the Dead Sea, lowest spot on earth, where those who desire may take a quick dip in the Dead Sea. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Feb. 24 - Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Old City Tour, Knessett, Model City

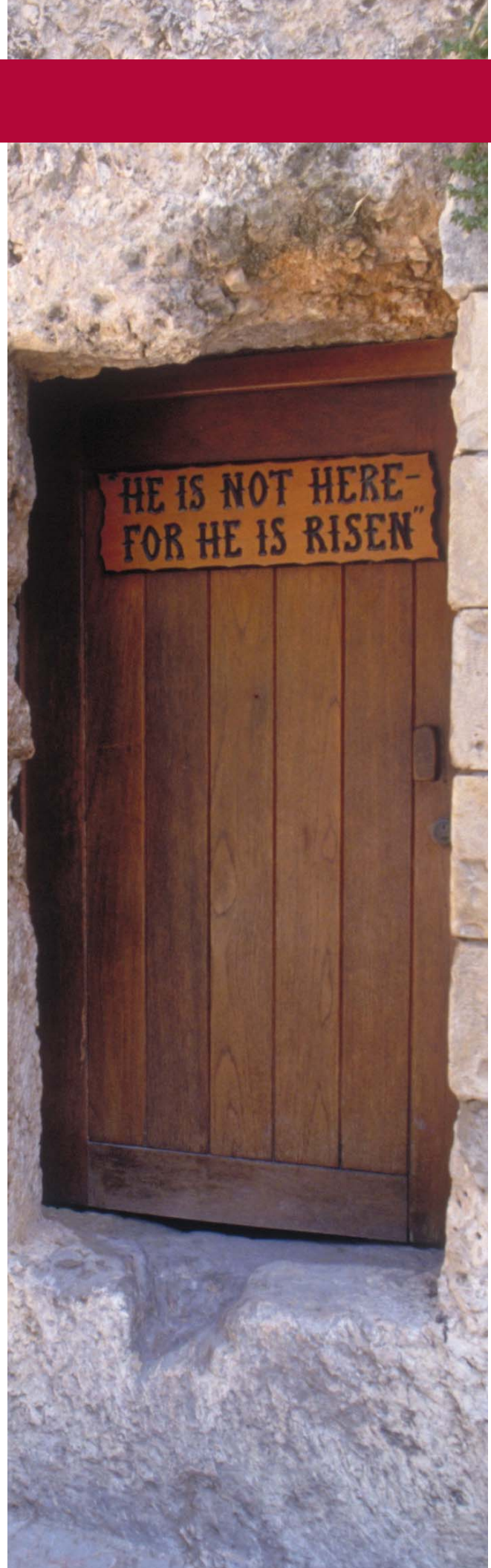
Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1:9-12). Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane among Olive Trees in the Kidron Valley across from the walls of Jerusalem. Continue your journey as you travel through the Old City to the Cardo. This ancient marketplace has ruins that date back to the Judean monarchy among modern shops. See the Knesset, the Israeli Parliament. Visit the Israel Museum and see the Model of 1st Century Jerusalem and the famous Dead Sea Scrolls. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Feb. 25 – Yad Vashem, Western Wall, Garden Tomb, Gordon’s Calvary

Continue to modern Jerusalem and visit the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and be touched by its poignant images. Say a prayer at the Western Wall. Also planned today is a stop at Gordon’s Calvary where we can sense the agony of Christ’s crucifixion and the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb. Return to your hotel this evening and prepare for your return home.

Feb. 26 - Depart Tel Aviv, Arrive in the USA

Today depart Tel Aviv on your international flight back to the USA. Return home with wonderful memories that will last a lifetime.

YOUR ACCOMMODATIONS will be in first class and/or deluxe hotels. If you do not have a roommate and NTS is unable to arrange one, you must pay a supplemental room charge of \$550. All single rooms are subject to availability and may be smaller than normal twin rooms.

YOUR LUGGAGE (one suitcase) will be handled for you upon arrival overseas (after you clear customs), transferred between hotels, piers, etc. Your carry-on will be your own responsibility.

PAYMENT: A full deposit of \$300 per person is required. Final payment for the trip, including travel protection premium, is due **NOVEMBER 18, 2010**. Thereafter, a late payment fee of \$100.00 will be assessed.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: 1) Optional Travel Protection Program; 2) Miscellaneous fees such as individual Transfers, Passports, Laundry, Beverages at Meals, Excess Baggage and Items of a Personal Nature; 3) NOTE: Non US Citizens must obtain any VISA's required for entry. 4) Fuel surcharges which may be imposed by airlines and other suppliers. If applicable, fuel surcharge will be paid by the passenger.

CHANGES: When a written request to change the standard program is approved by NTS, a minimum of \$80 per person, per change will be charged. Transfers for such passengers are not included in the program price and are solely the responsibility of the passenger.

CANCELLATION FEES: 100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. **Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties:** From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged a \$90 non-refundable administrative fee plus any airline fees. Additionally, thereafter, you will be charged any airline penalties and a single room supplement if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single plus the following charges: 104-60 days = \$400; 59-45 days = \$600; 44-31 days = 40% of total cost; 30 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. Cancellation request must be submitted in writing to NTS. On or after day of departure, there is no refund for any service not used.
